

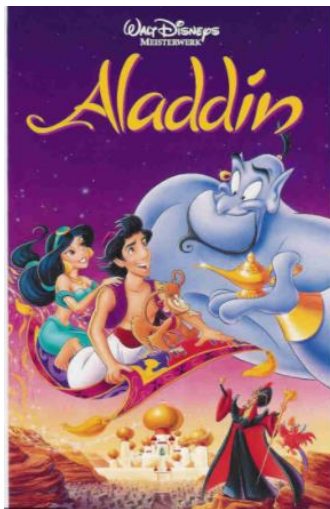

- Glue

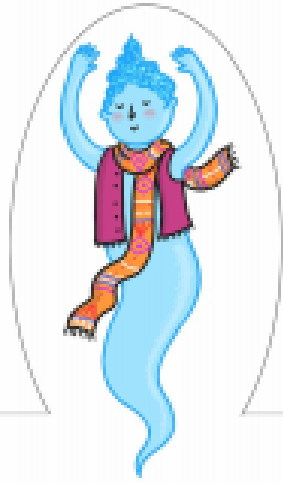
Instructions:

- Glue













Instructions:

- Scissors

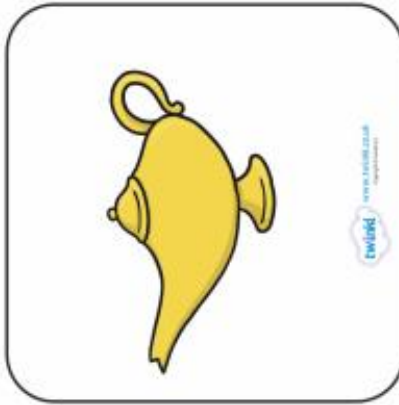

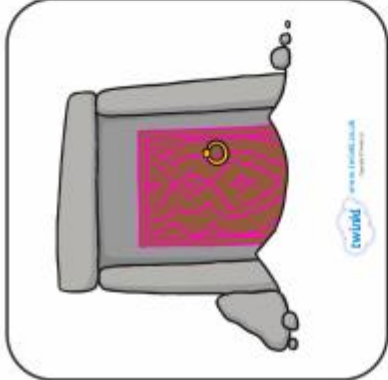
Can you play bingo with a partner and match the pictures correctly?

Can you play bingo by saying the name of the characters?

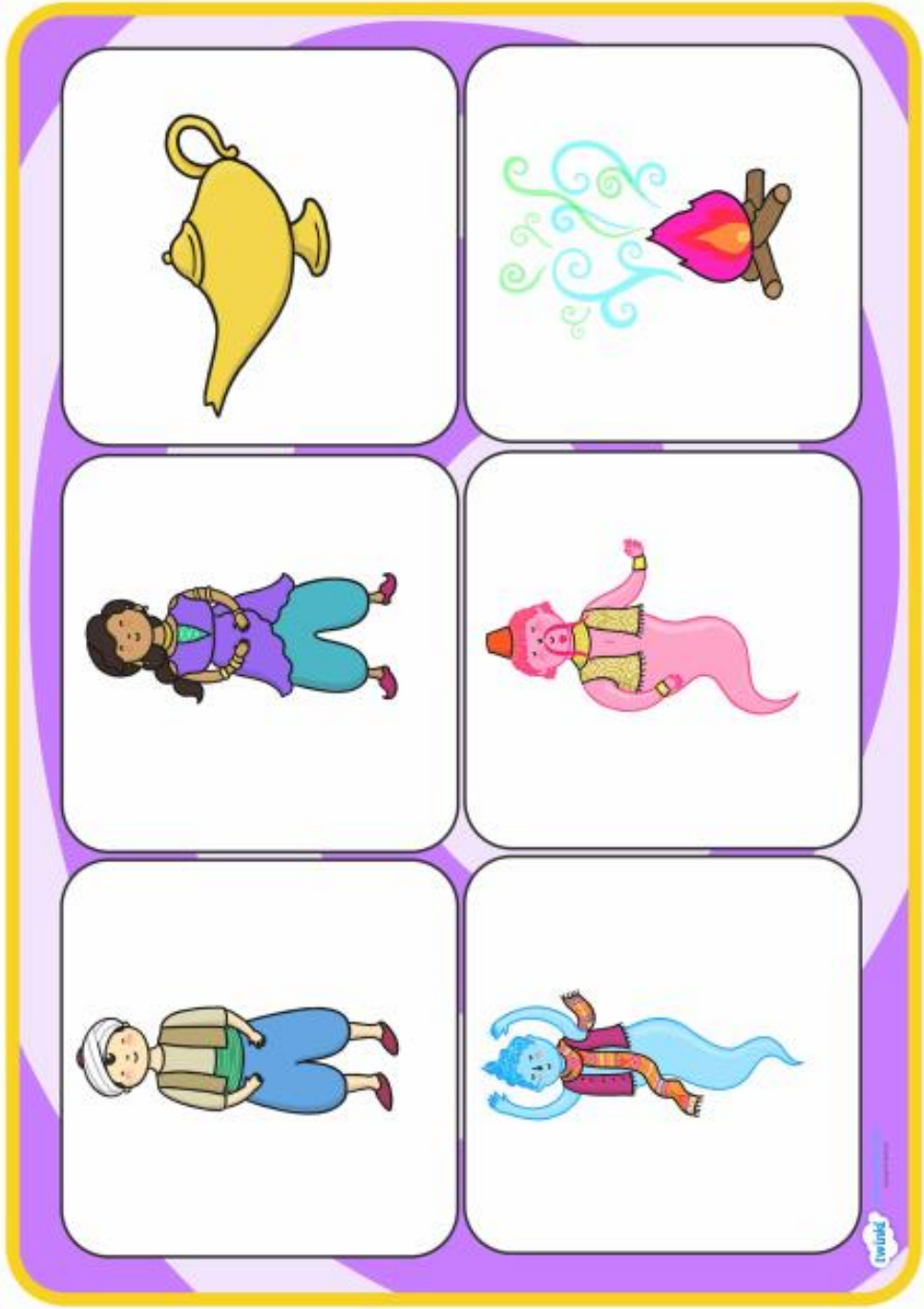

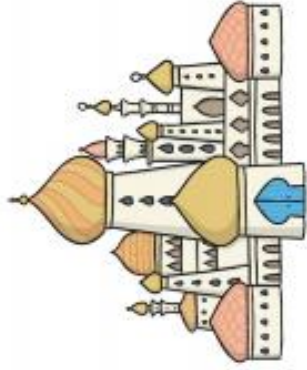
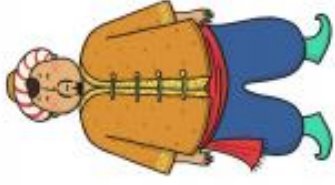

Equipment:

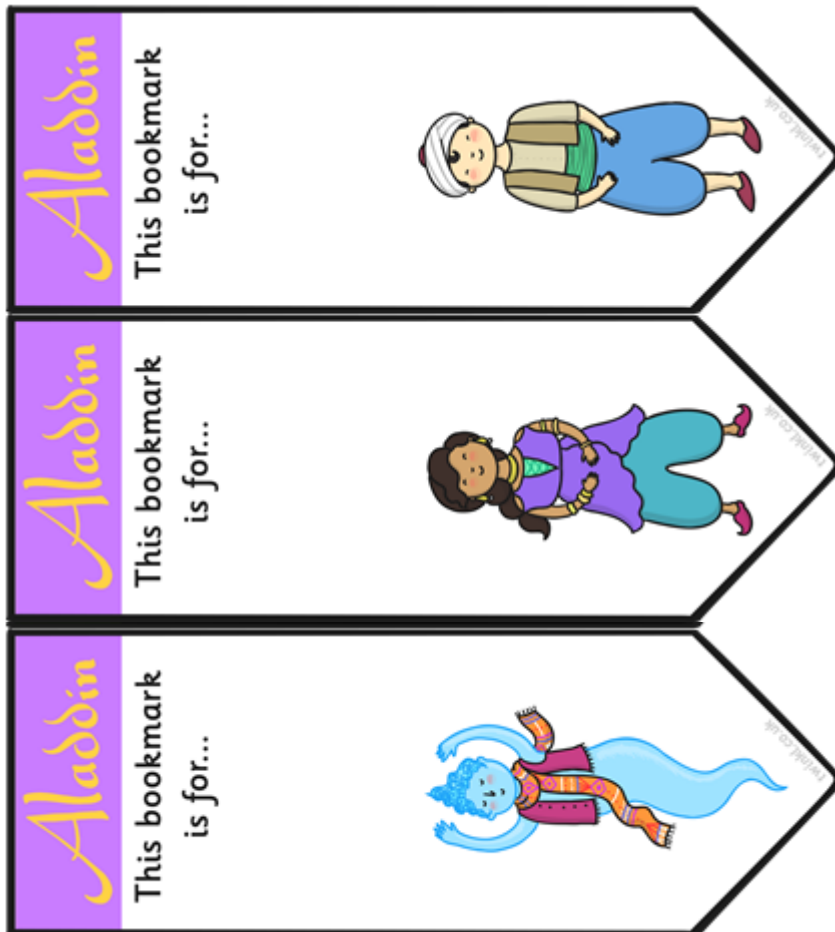
- Pencil

Can you cut out an Aladdin book mark and use a variety of colours and tools to decorate your own book mark?

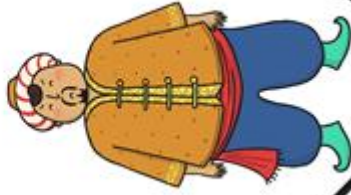
Can you decorate a book mark, thinking about the colours you use and take your time?

Can you make your own bookmark thinking about your favourite story? Could you draw a picture?

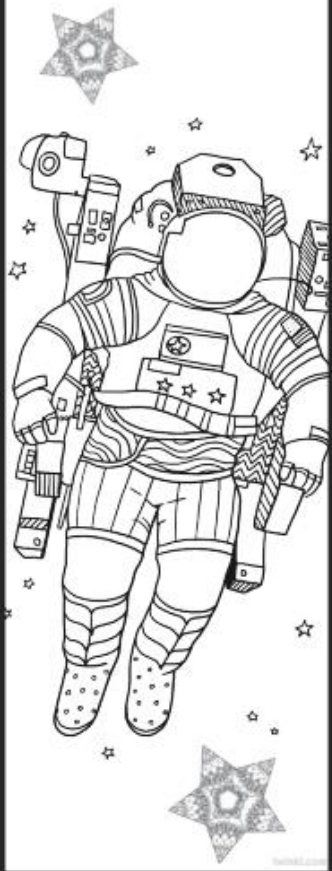

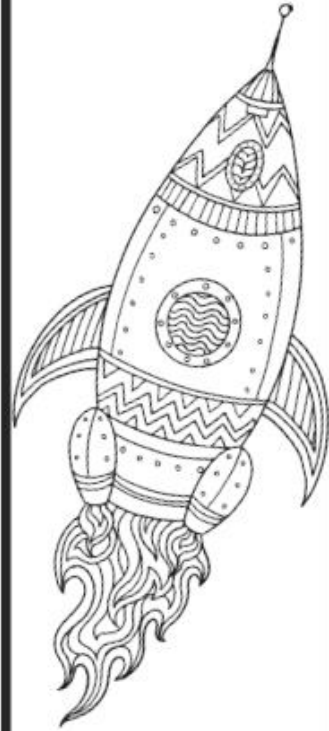

- Scarps of material /foil/sequins/string

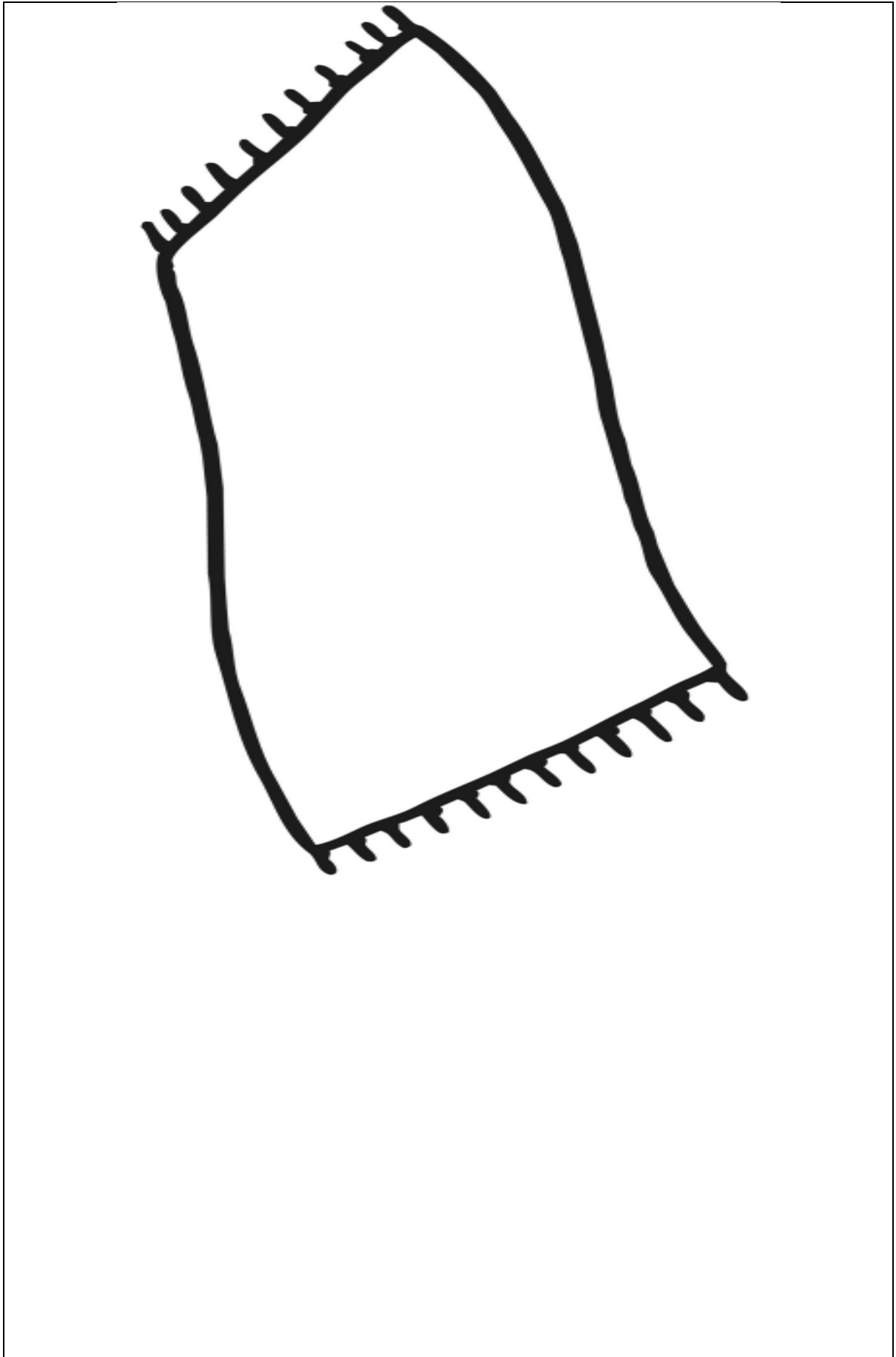
Instructions:

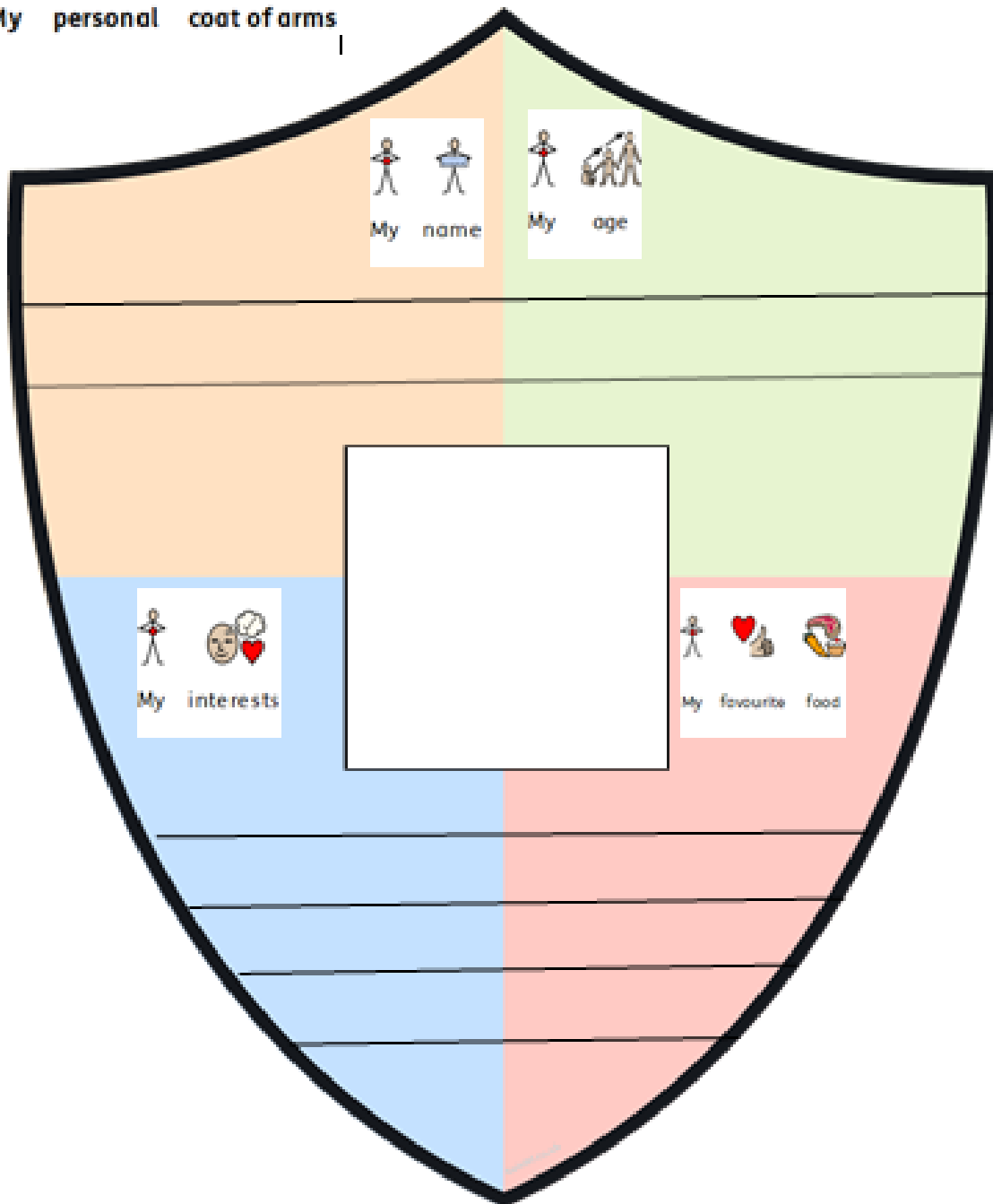
