

Spider toilet roll art

You will need



To make your spider shape cut the bottom of the toilet roll into the shape of 8 legs like this...



Now dip the shape into the paint and make your own spiders on paper!



You can draw your own eyes on or add googly eyes if you have some.

Once you have finished printing you can cut your toilet roll down and make a spider model.

Paint the rest of the toilet roll black and add eyes or googly eyes to finish it off.





Edible bugs

Try cooking these bugs!



Ingredients

- 1 pack of readymade pastry
- 8 cooked hot dog sausages or veggie sausages
- 1/2 to 3/4 cup potato stick crisps
- Ketchup *and/or* mustard

Method

- Preheat oven to 180° gas mark 4.
- Unroll and cut eight rectangular strips
- Cut sausages in half width wise.
- Wrap one piece of pastry around each sausage, leaving the rounded end showing.
- Place seam side down on an ungreased baking sheet.
- Bake 15-17 minutes or until golden brown.
- Remove bugs to a serving plate and cool 2 minutes.
- Push potato sticks into baked pastry for legs and antennae.
- Decorate with ketchup *and/or* mustard for eyes and spots.
- Serve warm.

Spring in an Ice Cube

Place them into an ice-cube tray or a small pot, fill with water and freeze.


Your child can play with the ice cubes and watch them melt to reveal the flowers.



Equipment:


- Plate/tray
